Planning Your Professional Learning

This course introduces teachers to the evidence base around teacher CPD and guides them through the process of creating a bespoke professional learning plan that will help drive their development forward and ensure that the CPD they engage with has impact – on themselves, their school and their pupils.

Teachers will be able to access tools and resources to aid this process, including:

- access to the Chartered College of Teaching's Professional Framework
- a professional learning plan process and template
- evidence-informed content to develop understanding of effective CPD practice.

Teachers will be signposted to other resources available as part of their Chartered College of Teaching membership that can support them in taking their plan forward.

Teachers will be able to receive formal certification for their learning by successfully completing a short end-of-course quiz which will assess their knowledge of the core course content.

Embedding a culture of evidence-informed practice - our group packages
